How do the modules work?

Try a heavy vehicle module on www.GoPlacesNow.co.nz

Module content covers the licence and certification process and essential information such as vehicle dimensions and weights, how to carry loads safely, documentation and log books.

The modules are engaging and interactive. You can read the questions yourself, or the audio can read them to you. If you get an answer wrong, you get feedback straightaway, and you can try as many times as you need to. Your progress is tracked so you know where you are at.
